



Sylvan Learning Scholarship



The Sylvan Learning scholarship is available for a student from K-8TH grade who is struggling with their academics and is a member or was a member of the 716Dance Lab. The purpose of the scholarship is to supplement a child's education to get them to where they need to be. Sylvan Learning understands that for the last 2 years, virtual learning has caused gaps in children's knowledge base and confidence. The gap in, in-person learning hindered the current growth in children, and Sylvan would like to help your child catch up and build confidence!

Sylvan will begin by administering an assessment to understand the targeted needs of the child. The assessment allows us to see where the child is in their understanding of concepts so a targeted learning plan can be created. This comprehensive assessment will look at Math, Reading and Writing skills. Students will work through our Sylvan Sync programming that will be built specifically for them, and has a hands-on approach to learning. The building of concepts allows children to understand better, but also build confidence where they are able to make sense and apply one concept to the next.

The scholarship includes:

- Comprehensive assessment (Math, Reading and Writing)
- 40 hours of learning sessions
- Progress assessment at the 28th session

- Student is below grade level average (please submit last report card)
- Feedback from school staff has not been negative in terms of academic growth or confidence,
- Child is having difficulty with understanding concepts
- Child becomes frustrated and there is a lack of motivation
- Child has difficulty completing homework after school
- The school has indicated that your child needs the support and they are working on remedial programming
- You want your child to succeed, and feel that Sylvan will definitely make the difference

Submission:

- 1) Last report card/feedback from school staff
- 2) 1 page explaining:
 - a. Why you want this scholarship?
 - b. How do you think this will benefit your child?
 - c. Feedback you have received from school and your own personal observations and conversations with your child
